# WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

5 Things the Thief Knew With Assurance...

1. He would **<u>FACE</u>** God after death.

"Don't you fear God even when you are dying?" Luke 23:40 (NLT)

"Everyone must die once, and after that be judged by God." Hebrews 9:27 (GNT)

### 2. He knew he had <u>SINNED</u> against God.

"We deserve to die for our evil deeds..." Luke 23:41 (NLT)

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23 (NIV)

#### 3. He knew <u>JESUS</u> was more than a mere man.

"...but this man hasn't done anything wrong!" Luke 23:41 (NLT)

"There is not a single person in all the earth who is always good and never sins." Ecclesiastes 7:20 (NLT)

"God had Christ, who was sinless, take our sin so that we might receive God's approval through him." 2 Corinthians 5:21 (GW)

### 4. He knew only <u>GRACE</u> could save him.

Then he said, "Jesus, remember me..." Luke 23:42 (NLT)

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-- not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV)

## 5. He knew that Jesus would save him if he <u>ASKED</u>.

"...when you come into your Kingdom." Luke 23:42 (NLT)

"Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved..." Acts 16:31 (NIV)

"Today" It is <u>IMMEDIATE</u>

"you will" It is <u>CERTAIN</u>

"be with me" It is <u>A RELATIONSHIP</u>
