1. Let go the weight of WORRY

“Worry weighs a person down.” Proverbs 12:25 (NLT)

“Let go of your concerns. Then you will know that I am God...I rule the earth.” Psalm 46:10 (GW)

My Worries ...

- Exhaust ENERGY
“I am worn out by my worries.” Psalm 55:2b (TEV)
- Exaggerate PROBLEMS
“My awful worries keep growing.”
Psalm 25:17 (CEV)

- Waste TIME
“Will your worries add a single moment to your life?
Matthew 6:27 (LB)

“Give your worries to the Lord, and He will take care of you.” Psalm 55:22 (NCV)

HOW? PRAYER

“Instead of worrying, pray. Let your petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness... will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life.” Philipians 4:6-7 (MSG)

2. Let go the whisper of WOUNDS

“My heart is wounded within me.” Psalm 109:22b (NIV)

“Let go of anger, and leave your rage behind. Do not be preoccupied. It only leads to evil.” Psalm 37:8 (GW)

“You are only hurting yourself with your anger.”
Job 18:4 (TEV)

HOW? FORGIVENESS

“Get rid of all bitterness... no more hateful feelings of any sort. Instead... forgive one another, as God has forgiven you through Christ.” Ephesians 4:31-32 (TEV)

“God heals the brokenhearted and bandages their wounds.” Psalm 147:3 (NCV)

3. Let go the wrestling with WRONGS

My wrongs ...

- DISCONNECT me
“Your wrongs have separated you from your God, and your sins have made Him hide His face so that He doesn't hear you.” Isaiah 59:2 (GW)
- DEPRESS Me
“When I refused to confess my sin, I was weak and miserable, and I groaned all day long.”
Psalm 32:3 (NLT)

“I know about my wrongs, and I can't forget my sin.”
Psalm 51:3(NCV)

HOW? CONFESSION

“If we confess our sins, he will forgive our sins... and cleanse us from all the wrongs we have done.”
1 John 1:9 (NCV)

“God, be merciful to me because You are loving...Wipe out all my wrongs. Wash away all my guilt and make me clean again.”
Psalm 51:1-2 (NCV)

“You (God) will forgive them and put them away;
You will wipe out all the wrongs I have done.”
Job 14:17 (TEV)
